CNIPA: RMB Fee Standard of PCT International Application

Implements as of July 1, 2023

In accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding for Remittance of (PCT) Fees signed between the CNIPA and the WIPO, China National Intellectual Property Administration will collect the fees for PCT international applications on behalf of the International Bureau of the WIPO in accordance with the RMB standard published by WIPO.

According to the RMB Fee standard of PCT international applications promulgated by the WIPO on July 1, 2023, the CNIPA will charge fees for the international phase of PCT international applications according to the following criteria.
